#### Economic Development – Power & Utility Impacts

#### Existing & New Business – Needs Changing/Growing

- Higher Electric & Gas Consumption
  - Ensure capacity available asking for 100 200 MW vs 1 MW
  - Timeframes for adding capacity construct / regulations / equipment availability
- Looking for Renewable or Carbon Free Energy
  - Xcel Energy Clean Energy Plan = 80%+ carbon free by 2030, 100% carbon free by 2050
  - Working to add more wind & solar transmission challenges
  - Ensure **reliable** energy available

#### **Territory Growth**

- Communities at capacity for available acreage
- New areas potentially competitive for utilities
- Utilities need to be extended to new areas.






