Program Update

Background

The Eau Claire County ARPA Committee was established by Eau Claire County and is tasked with providing oversight and community awareness to the administration of regranting a portion of the County ARPA funds, specifically \$2 million in funds targeted to small business and nonprofit entities. Eau Claire County hired the West Central Wisconsin Regional Planning Commission (WCWRPC) as the third-party administrator of the funds. WCWRPC was charged with facilitating the Committee's discussions on developing and finalizing the requirements of the grant program and grant administration.

At its February 28, 2022, meeting, the Eau Claire County ARPA Committee reviewed and agreed upon the final version of Eau Claire County's American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA) Recovery Assistance Grant Program – inclusive of Components #1 and #2. An allocation of \$1 million per Component was approved.

In addition, the Eau Claire County ARPA Committee established a subcommittee – the Eau Claire County ARPA Application Review Committee – to assist with review and final approval of the Eau Claire County ARPA Recovery Assistance Grant Program Component #1 and #2 applicants.

Component #1 Eligibility Criteria

Under Component 1, small businesses and nonprofit organizations could apply for \$5,000 grants to help mitigate the impacts of the pandemic and assist with recovery. To be eligible, a business or nonprofit needed to satisfy all criteria listed below:

- Be located within Eau Claire County;
- Have been in operation in Eau Claire County on or before March 25, 2020, and still in operation; and,
- Have suffered an economic loss because of the COVID-19 pandemic and provide documentation of COVID-19 pandemic impact.

Businesses needed to employ less than twenty (20) employees, including the owner(s); and the business could not be a lessor of real estate (landlord); property management company; or a political organization.

Nonprofit organizations needed to have a 501(c)(3) charitable status and operate within one of the following categories:

- Affordable Housing and Homelessness
- Animal / Environmental
- Arts, Culture, and Humanities
- Early Childhood Education / Education
- Health

- Family, Children, and Human Services
- Low Income
- Mental Health and Addiction
- Underrepresented Populations / Minority Persons

Component #1 was organized to provide priority for applicants who had not received any previous pandemic relief assistance with secondary priority given to businesses or nonprofits with the largest loss in sales or revenue compared to pre-pandemic levels.

Component #1 Application Process

The following process steps were used for Component #1:

- 1) Program was advertised over an approximately four-week period which included:
 - a. Press release to media sources throughout the County.
 - b. Social media (Facebook, LinkedIn) posts with reposting by other organizations.
 - c. Mailing to Eau Claire County and municipal (Town, Village, City) elected officials and County Board members.
 - d. MailChimp newsletter to WCWRPC contacts located in Eau Claire County.
 - e. Emails to Eau Claire County Chambers of Commerce and other organizations.
 - f. Communication to County organizations, such as the Chippewa Valley COVID-19 Economic Recovery Task Force, Chippewa Valley Equality Initiative, and Eau Claire Area Economic Development Corporation, to get information in appropriate newsletters.
- 2) WCWRPC was available to answer program and application questions.
- 3) Two WCWRPC staff separately reviewed each application and the required attachments to determine eligibility. A checklist was completed for each applicant. A third staff member reviewed the information for accuracy of inputted information.
- 4) WCWRPC contacted any incomplete applicant at least two times (via email and phone) to request additional information.
- 5) A spreadsheet of application submissions was prepared.

Approved Applications

Component 1 application submissions were due by 5:00 p.m. on April 26, 2022. A total of 96 Component 1 applications were submitted. At a May 19, 2022 Application Review Committee meeting, 89 of the 96 submitted applications were deemed eligible and approved. Following the meeting it was determined that while two of the applicants are in the City of Eau Claire, and applications indicated they were located in Eau Claire County, they are in fact located in Chippewa County, making them ineligible for this grant program. Other ineligible applications did not meet the previously mentioned program criteria. Because of the lower than anticipated number of submissions, applications did not need to be prioritized for funding.

29% of approved applications were from 501(c)(3) nonprofit organizations, with the majority (71%) from businesses.

Of the small business grant recipients, 5 owners identified as being a veteran, 41 owners identified as being a woman, and 9 owners identified as a minority.



Component #2 Eligibility Criteria

Under Component 2, small businesses and nonprofit organizations could apply for grants between \$10,000 and \$100,000 for forward thinking and innovative projects, programs, or efforts that would assist the greater community in recovery from the pandemic. To be eligible, a business or nonprofit needed to be located in Eau Claire County.

Businesses needed to employ less than twenty (20) employees, including the owner(s); and the business could not be a lessor of real estate (landlord); property management company; or a political organization.

Nonprofit organizations needed to have a 501(c)(3) charitable status and operate within one of the following categories:

- Affordable Housing and Homelessness
- Animal / Environmental
- Arts, Culture, and Humanities
- Early Childhood Education / Education
- Health
- Family, Children, and Human Services

- Low Income
- Mental Health and Addiction
- Small Business Assistance
- Underrepresented Populations / Minority Persons

Applicants needed to answer six narrative questions as part of the application. The narrative needed to provide information on the problem to be addressed, the proposed project, a project timeline, staffing and partnerships, a budget, and disproportionally impacted communities or populations, if applicable.

Component #2 Application Process

The following process steps were followed for Component #2:

- 1) Program was advertised over an approximately six-week period which included:
 - a. Press release to media sources throughout the County.
 - b. Social media (Facebook, LinkedIn) posts with reposting by other organizations.
 - c. Mailing to Eau Claire County and municipal (Town, Village, City) elected officials and County Board members.
 - d. MailChimp newsletter to WCWRPC contacts located in Eau Claire County.
 - e. Emails to Eau Claire County Chambers of Commerce and other organizations.
 - f. Communication to County organizations, such as the Chippewa Valley COVID-19 Economic Recovery Task Force, Chippewa Valley Equality Initiative, and Eau Claire Area Economic Development Corporation, to get information in appropriate newsletters.
- 2) WCWRPC was available to answer program and application questions.
- 3) A WCWRPC staff member reviewed each application and required attachments to determine initial eligibility. A checklist was completed for each applicant.
- 4) WCWRPC contacted any incomplete applicant at least two times (via email and phone) to request additional information.
- 5) A spreadsheet of application submissions was prepared.
- 6) An application binder was prepared for use by the Application Review Committee for scoring purposes.

Next Steps

Component 2 applications were due by 5:00 p.m. on May 16, 2022. A total of 59 applications were submitted requesting approximately \$4.5 million. WCWRPC staff have reviewed the applications for completeness; the Application Review Committee will begin to review and score submitted applications following a June 24, 2022 training session. It is anticipated that awardees will be determined by late August.
