




### TRUMP VS. HARRIS WISCONSIN POLLING AVERAGES






### GENERAL ELECTION TRUMP-HARRIS MATCHUP

## For Trump to Win


- Focus needs to be on the economy/inflation and immigration/border.

- Stay positive.











Democrats need to win all their competitive seats and pick up 4 GOP












# 8TH CD TONY WIED (R) VS KRISTIN LYERLY (D)









- Owner/operator of Red Cedar Chiropractic




# Joe Plouff (D-Menomonie)

- US Army veteran



57% of the district is new for Rep. Moses. Menomonee sat on the eastern end of the old 29th, but sits on the western side of the new 92nd.



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

- Founder and CEO of Sajan, Inc., a cloud-based information technology and localization company



- Previously served on River Falls school board








Under the new maps, Rep. Zimmerman picks up the remainder of the city of River Falls, making 25% of the district new for him.





### X % more than DEM at Top









# CURRENTLY REPUBLICANS HAVE A 22-11 SUPER MAJORITY IN THE STATE SENATE














#### WRAP UP

- New Maps & Retirements = likely historic legislative turnover
- In the Senate, Democrats can narrow majority in '24, but no path to majority until '26, but that requires significant wins in '24.
- In Assembly, Democrats can significantly narrow majority and then it comes down to individual candidates and races.
