Governor D-R margin by population density Governor D-R margin change 2018-22 by population density





















Senate R-D margin change 2016-22 by population density

Size proportional to total vote




Senate R-D margin by population density



Vote preference, US Senate, likely voters







Vote preference, governor, likely voters



Vote preference for governor, likely voters












Evers job approval, disapproval, and don't know ratings




Financial situation, with party ID






Percent 'very concerned'






Inflation concern, Aug. 2021-Oct. 2022










Confidence in accuracy of 2022 election, with party ID Oct. 24-Nov. 1, 2022


Biden job approval, with party ID












Biden job approval, disapproval and don't know ratings
