
## Serving in Local Government – Jessica Schoen (Eau Claire City Council)

## **Key Takeaways:**

- The time demand varies a lot week-to-week/month-to-month.
- Most council hours in one week: 20 hours, 15 minutes
- Least council hours in one week: 1 hour, 30 minutes
- Average council hours per week: Approximately 8 hours

## Things to Keep in Mind:

- Each elected representative has different professional and personal responsibilities outside of their role as an elected official that impact their capacity to attend meetings, meet with constituents, and participate in other ways.
- These numbers reflect my personal experience. Others may have very different schedules and commitments.
