Community-Minded Initiatives

The UWEC Foundation's / Blugold Real Estate Foundation's commitment to community extends far beyond education. In 2024, The Sonnentag opened its doors to the community. The Sonnentag is the largest Leadership in Energy and Environmental Design in V4 gold-certified recreational center in the nation operated by a public university. The 229,900-square-foot facility is estimated to have generated \$38 million in construction wages and benefits to dozens of firms and hundreds of workers who helped build the facility.

They have also worked on and built The Children's Nature Academy, The Confluence Arts Center (now known as the Pablo Center at the Confluence), and Haymarket Landing.

The Haymarket development was estimated to have generated more than \$100 million in new construction in Downtown Eau Claire and since its establishment, it has been a catalyst for the rebirth and re-energization of the City of Eau Claire.

In addition, they have a contract with the university to manage the Aspenson Mogensen Apartments at 222 Water Street.
